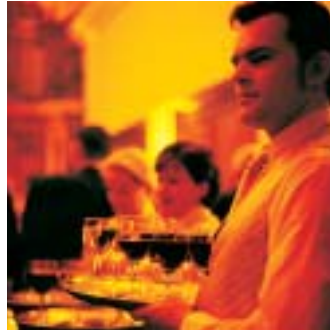

THE RHK IS THE OLDEST SURVIVING NEO-CLASSICAL BUILDING IN IRELAND. ORIGINALLY BUILT AS A HOSPICE FOR RETIRED SOLDIERS AND INSPIRED BY LES INVALIDES IN PARIS.



In the 19th century, the RHK became the residence and headquarters of the Commander and Chief of the Army, who combined the role with that of Master of the Royal Hospital. Queen Victoria paid two visits to the building, which was eventually handed over to the Free State in 1922.

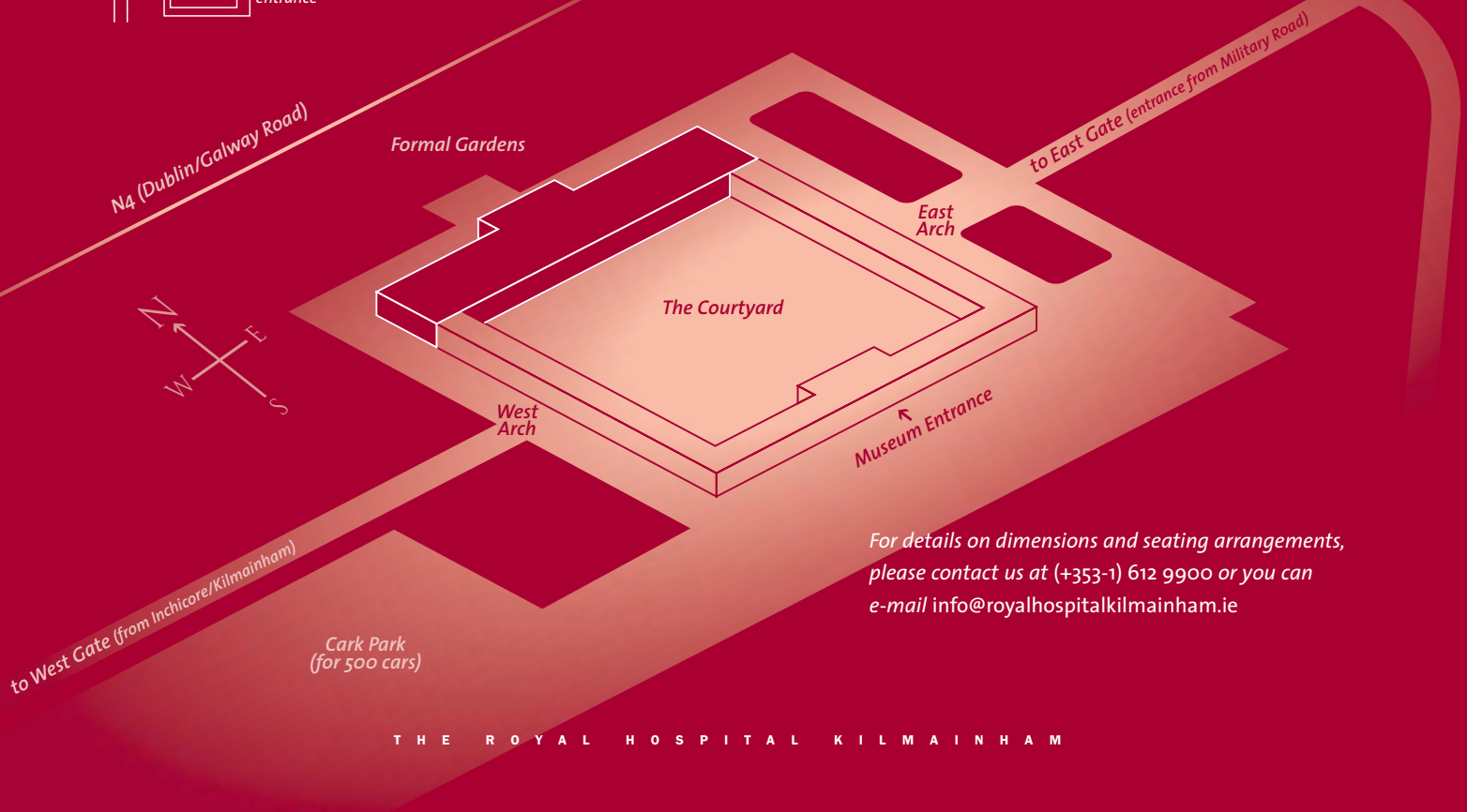
